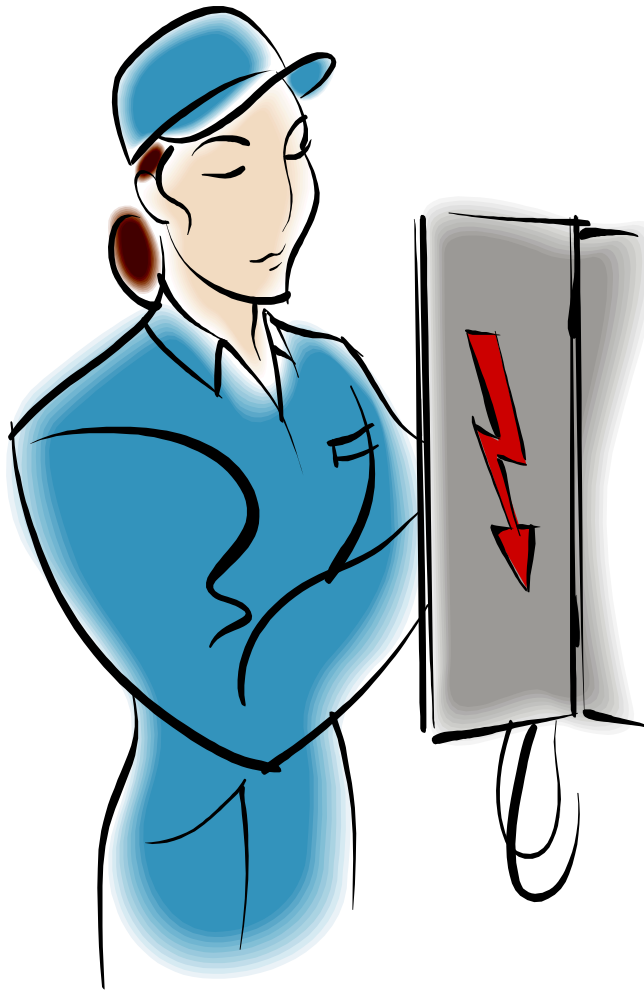


# Do you have the Key?

Keep hazardous energy locked up.



- ◆ Occasionally, University of Tennessee personnel may Lock and Tag Out Hazardous Energy Sources.
- ◆ Accidents and injuries associated with unexpected equipment start up during maintenance and repair activities can be serious. Amputations, electrocutions and fatalities can occur due to failure to follow accepted lockout/tagout procedures.
- ◆ If you encounter what appears to be a Lock Out Tag Out (LOTO) situation do not tamper with or bypass the protections in place.
- ◆ LOTO should have a lock and a detailed tag explaining who is responsible and appropriate contact information. A LOTO can only be removed by the person who put it in place.
- ◆ Tape over breakers in electrical panels is not an appropriate substitute for a breaker lock. If you encounter an uncertain situation use caution and immediately notify your supervisor or **Environmental Health & Safety (EHS)** at 974-5084
