<input type="checkbox"/> True <input type="checkbox"/> False	Space contains a material that has the potential for engulfing an entrant.	
<input type="checkbox"/> True <input type="checkbox"/> False	Space has an internal configuration such that an entrant could be trapped or asphyxiated by inwardly converging walls or by a floor which slopes and tapers to a smaller cross section.

<input type="checkbox"/> Permit-Required Confined Space – One or more of the above conditions are true.

Entry Operations Determination		
<input type="checkbox"/> Non-Permit Confined Space – Be aware that the introduction of additional hazards by the work to be performed may cause entry operations to become permit-required.		
<input type="checkbox"/> Permit-Required Confined Space – This is a permit-required confined space. Follow all appropriate entry procedures if entry is desired.		

<input type="checkbox"/> Possible Reclassification Confined Space – This is a permit-required confined space. Reclassification may be allowed provided the space poses no actual or potential atmospheric hazards and if all hazards within the space are eliminated without entry into the space. The space may be reclassified to a non-permit space as long as the non-atmospheric hazards remain eliminated.
<input type="checkbox"/> Possible Alternate-Entry Confined Space – This is a permit-required confined space. Entry operations are allowed provided the only hazard posed is an actual or potential hazardous atmosphere which can be controlled by continuous forced air ventilation alone.
