Hazard Analysis:

**Cleaning (Sweeping/Mopping/Buffering)**

Task	Hazard	Cause	Prevention
General Use	Trauma	Projectiles, impact, chemical contact	Situational awareness, gloves, protective clothing
	Foot Injury	Dropped object on foot	Wear safety shoes
	Ingestion	Chemicals, dust	Wear respirator or dust mask if needed

**PPE Required:**

- Safety Shoes/boots
- Gloves (optional) protective Clothing (long pants recommended to prevent chemical splash on skin)
- Respirator or dust mask (as needed)

This document serves as the Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Certification document required to satisfy the federal requirements of the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) Standard, 29 CFR 1910.132 Subpart I- Personal Protective Equipment.
