



Hydrofluoric Acid (HF) is used and/or stored in this area.

- HF causes severe skin burns and eye damage which may not be immediately painful or visible.
- It can be <u>Fatal</u> if swallowed, by contact with skin, or if inhaled.
- Only trained individuals may use HF.
- An HF first aid kit must be available and maintained.
- Accidental contact is an emergency, and medical attention must be sought immediately. Call 911 and inform the emergency responders that a hydrofluoric acid exposure has occurred.
