# **Topic Summaries:**

#### I. Introductions/Opening

The LSC Chair, Dr. Sarah Mobley, opened the meeting at 1:32pm.

### II. Approve Minutes from Last Meeting (April 10, 2025)

The minutes from 4/10/2025 were approved as written with 4 abstentions.

#### **III. Safety Culture Minute**

Sarah Mobley recognized Emily Deem and Linda Hamilton for their initiative in meeting with all IBC members for a discussion of IBC function. This program will be replicated for the LSC. Sarah also

recognized Larry McKay for the work on the field guide for safety and Adrian Gonzalez for presenting on the importance of Safety (Culture) Minutes in research groups.

#### **IV. Committee Reports**

<u>Lab Safety Culture Awards</u> – Carolina Carter announced that the subcommittee is now accepting submissions for Quarter 2, where the topic is Spring Cleaning. The Quarter 1 award has been issued. Submissions for Quarter 2 are due by June 9.

<u>Institutional Biosafety Committee</u> – Emily Deem reported that Dr. Joseph Jackson from the Graduate School of Medicine is now serving as the Vice-Chair of the IBC.

#### V. Incidents/Concerns

Alisun Smith-Bryant reported on two incidents. The first incident was regarding a power tool that resulted in wood dust irritating the eye of the user. The individual was wearing glasses. The second incident involved a laceration to the finger while using a carving tool. The associated group is looking into obtaining Kevlar gloves.

#### VI. Summer Break Projects

Linda Hamilton and Sarah Mobley are planning to meet with all LSAs to discuss LSA and LSC function. The LSAs are asked during the summer to evaluate processes that they engage in that may need improvement. The new onboarding for Research Operations Commissioning will hopefully be rolled out during the summer and fall.

Linda introduced a high-level overview of the new commissioning process. The process begins with interviewing candidates and follows through a commissioning timeline. Process changes include the introduction of a pre-commissioning consultation form, rewriting the Research Operations Commissioning document, and editing the lab commissioning checklist. Spaces that do not obviously fall under the title of "lab" are still under question of purview. A clearer definition of "lab" is needed along with the guidance of if these spaces, that may not be "labs", still need signage in case of emergency for hazard communication.

#### VII. Special Topics Workshop – Facilities Discussion

Guests Matt Motsko and Wayne Parsons from Facilities Services joined Randy Huelsman and the LSC for a roundtable discussion on touchpoints between Facilities and research groups. Topics such as janitorial access, PPE training, work requests, communication, and room signage were explored for how the impacted groups can serve each other better. Research groups are encouraged to speak up about janitorial schedules and access if they do not fit their needs. In addition, work requests are encouraged to contain as much detail as possible (given character limits) and include pictures if possible. The main area of improvement was communication. Signage will be revisited at a later time, but it is a very important mechanism of communication between labs/spaces and Facilities.

#### VIII. Old Business

Linda provided an update on the incident that precipitated a conversation about incident response procedures for students (non-employees) on campus relating to medical treatment. Dr. Rebecca Morgan, Medical Director of the Student Health Center, is drafting guidance for assisting students who are injured in the process of doing research.

#### IX. LSS Updates

Brian Ranger introduced the reorganization of EHS, effective July 1. EHS is introducing Associate and Assistant Director positions to oversee larger groups of the department. The impact to groups within the LSC should be minimal for day-to-day operations, but some points of contact and program interaction may change. Notably, Linda Hamilton will be overseeing a group focused on program effectiveness, which will help identify gaps in communication and outreach. Marsha Smith will oversee a combined LSS and Rad Safety group that will be focused on research and academic safety.

### X. Next Meeting

In lieu of a formal LSC meeting, all members are invited to participate in the TCE Safety Inservice Day on August 14, 2025. Schedule is to be determined. Sarah Mobley was congratulated on her first year of Chair of the LSC.
